Unpacking the Standards Unit 8: WWI to WWII

At the end of the Unit: Students should be able to explain the United State's rise to being a world power, and how Georgia contributed. Students should be able to explain how Georgia contributed to World War I efforts, the factors that led to the Great Depression in Georgia, and the New Deal Programs. Students should also be familiar with Eugene Talmadge and Franklin D. Roosevelt and their relationship with Georgia during the Great Depression. This will include being able to describe certain New Deal Programs. Students should also be able to describe how Georgia contributed to the war efforts during World War II, including the causes of the War, economic impact of war efforts, and the contributions of Richard Russel and Carl Vinson.

Standards:

SS8H8 Analyze Georgia's participation in important events that occurred from World War I through the Great Depression.

- b. Explain economic factors that resulted in the Great Depression. (e.g., boll weevil and drought).

- d. Discuss President Roosevelt's ties to Georgia, including his visits to Warm Springs and his impact on the state.
- e. Examine the effects of the New Deal in terms of the impact of the Civilian Conservation Corps, Agricultural Adjustment Act, Rural Electrification Administration, and Social Security Administration.

- a. Describe key events leading up to American involvement in World War II; include the Lend-Lease Act and the bombing of Pearl Harbor.
